## DOORS:

Doors will open at $6: 30 \mathrm{pm}$, with the performance beginning at 7:30pm.
PARKING:
We have free parking available in three (3) lots for a total capacity of approximately 100 -vehicles. If coming with friends, car pooling is suggested. Our main parking lot is located directly across the street from the venue. Once full, our volunteers will open and direct traffic to each additional lot.

VENUE:
The Packing House is located at The Mill Works facility, 156 River Road (RT32), Willington, CT. The building was built in 1870, and is listed on the CT State and National Register of Historic Places. Our capacity is 140.

We will have packaged snacks and soft drinks available for purchase. We also offer a BYOB\&F Model (Bring Your Own Beverage \& Food). However - due to limited table seating and overwhelming response for this concert, we recommend you consider eating prior to the show. Our sponsor, Willington Pizza and Willington Pizza Too, each located just a mile away, will honor a $15 \%$ discount off your entire order by presenting your paid ticket the day of the show (may we suggest The Packing House Pizza!).

## TICKETS:

All tickets to this performance are "General Admission" with no reserved seating. Therefore, seats are first come - first served.

## SEATING:

Our seating is composed of Cabaret Seating (15-small tables, each with seating for 4); Hi-Top Seating (12-HiTop tables, each with seating for 2): and Theater Seating (7-chairs per row without tables). With the number of folks anticipated to attend this performance, we will not be able to move tables and chairs around the venue. Cabaret tables which seat 4 , will be shared (you may be sitting with someone you may not know). If you are coming with a group, we suggest arriving early - however, we are unable to guarantee you will be able to sit together.
